1. The written word of God

- a. The scriptures are the inspired word of God
- b. The scriptures are the inerrant word of God
- c. The scriptures are <u>sufficient</u> to equip us for a life of faith and practice
- d. The scriptures are <u>authoritative</u> for the life of the believer

Four Tiers of "Theological Triage"

(Taken From Gavin Ortlund)

- I. Essential (gospel, and things essential to it)
- 2. **Urgent** (to the health and practice of the church)
- 3. **Important** (but not enough to separate over)
- 4. **Unimportant** (to our gospel witness and ministry collaboration)

Small Group Questions:

- 1. Have you ever heard somebody refer to the "closed-handed" matters of the faith, and the "open-handed" matters of the faith? What do you think they mean by this?
