4. Read the following verses out loud as a group: 1 Samuel 5:3, 4; Exodus 3:5; Nehemiah 9:5; 1 Kings 8:54; Psalm 95:6; and 1 Timothy 2:8. What are some of the responses to God in worship? Which responses are difficult for you?
5. Read 2 Samuel 6:12-23
 - A. What was David’s response in worship?
 - B. What was Michal’s response to her husband’s worship?
 - C. Why do you think they each responded as they did?
 - D. What does verse 22 mean for your life...”I will become even more undignified than this, and I will be humiliated in my own eyes?”
6. The following priority was given for worship...

We worship for God, first.
We worship for others, second.
We worship for ourselves, third.

Do you agree with this priority? What makes living out this priority difficult?
6. Who do you tend to be critical of in worship? Why?
7. What your most natural, authentic position of worship?
