1. When have you helped someone in a difficult place? What was that like for you?
2. Share some examples from the Bible where God takes a little and does a lot. (Matthew 14:13-21; Mark 5:21-34; Luke 7:1-10; Luke 17:1-6)
3. What does the following statement mean to you? “When you don’t have what you really want, you will discover that God is what you really need.”
4. Read 2 Kings 4:1-4.
 - A. How would you describe the woman in this story base on her response?
 - B. What do you notice about Elisha’s response to the woman?
5. Do you feel like the woman in this story? Does it feel overwhelming? As a group, see if there are concerns that could be shared and prayed for at this time.
6. Elisha tells the woman to gather jars. How many jars would you have gathered?
7. What is something “small” you have that you need to trust God with?
8. After going through this series on Elisha, what do the following phrases mean to you: “Burn some plows”; “Dig some ditches”; and “Gather some jars”? Which phrase do you need to focus the most?
