9. In your estimation, which is more important, for a child to have a good education or have a personal relationship with Jesus?
10. Read Colossians 2:6-7. "So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness."
11. What are some creative ways to teach your children, grandchildren, about God?
12. How can you demonstrate to your children or grandchildren that associating with the church family is a priority to you?
