 - B. What do you notice about the woman in the story?
 - C. What do you notice about Jesus in the story?
5. What are your first thoughts when you encounter someone, who is different than you?
6. Read John 4:27-39.
 - A. The woman went back to her town. What did she do that made everyone come out to see Jesus?
 - B. What could you do that could make people want to come and see Jesus?
 - C. What do you notice about the disciples in this story?
7. “My food,” said Jesus, “is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work. Don’t you have a saying, ‘It’s still four months until harvest’? I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest.” (John 4:34-35)
 - A. What do these verses mean to you in regards to harvest?
 - B. Share ideas, as a group, as to how you could “open your eyes” to people who don’t know Jesus.
