3. We know that no one is beyond God's love, but there are certain people that we think are pretty close. Who comes to mind?
4. Saul was Paul's Jewish name. Paul was the name he used when he was around Gentiles. What do you know about Saul before he becomes a Christian? Read Acts 7:58-8:3, 9:1-2; Galatians 1:13-14.
4. Read Acts 9:3-19.
 - A. Do you think Saul knew that this was God speaking to him?
 - B. How would you have reacted if this happened to you?
 - C. What stands out to you from these verses about Saul, Jesus and Ananias?
5. What has God done in your life to get your attention? How has He pursued you?
6. Read 1 Timothy 2:15. Does it surprise you that Paul would write these words?
7. Do you think Saul could have said "No" when God told Saul, in Damascus, that the journey that he was calling him to would be hard? Why or why not?
8. What are the implications of not changing when God calls you to change?
9. How is God nudging you now?
10. What did Paul do for the Kingdom of God by saying "yes" to God?
