Sermon: The Roadblocks to All-In

1. Do you believe you are on a mission from God? If so, what is your mission?

2. What do you think about the statistic that the average church member attends church 1.7 times per month? What does that say about today's church? Do you believe that is true for Capital City?

3. Do you believe it is better to have never heard the Good News of Jesus Christ or to have heard it, responded to it and turned away from it?

4. Read 2 Peter 2:20-21. What does Peter have to say about question 3? Why do you think Peter responds this way?

5. Read Matthew 13:1-8.
 - A. In this passage, what does the seed represent?
 - B. In this passage, who does the soil represent?
 - C. Four types of soil are mentioned in this passage; what is one thing you need to do to become the type of soil that "produces a crop-a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown."

6. Many people never make it from Getting Started to Digging Deeper. Why? If you have moved to Digging Deeper, how did you make progress?

7. What holds you back from trusting God completely, with everything?

8. Here are the Roadblocks to making progress on the Path of a Disciple.

Roadblock #1 – We ask Jesus to be Savior, but not Lord.

Roadblock #2 – Fear tempts us to go back to what is comfortable.

Roadblock #3 – The Church is doing its' job.

Roadblock #4 – Pride, especially in the Just Looking stage.

Roadblock #5 – We want it to be all about “me”, especially in the Getting Started stage.

Roadblock #6 – We tend to grow judgmental and arrogant, especially in the Digging Deeper stage.

*Which of these roadblocks have you encountered on your path as a disciple? Are you dealing with any of the roadblocks right now?

9. Read Ephesians 4:13. What does it mean to be All-In as a Jesus follower?

10. What stage are you at on the Path of a Disciple? (Just Looking, Getting Started, Digging Deeper or All-In) What is one step you must take to make progress to the next stage?
