2. Read Hebrews 3:13. How should we go about living out this verse?
3. What are some cultural rules that clash with God's rules?
4. Throughout this series, the word church (ekklesia) has been described as not a building, but a way of life—a way of life that includes these one another's. What are you learning about being the church?
5. Read Hebrews 3:12-13.
  - A. How does verse 12 affect your thoughts on encouraging one another?
  - B. How does it make you feel **knowing someone else's business is your business** since we are the church and we don't want people to drift away?
6. What do you think about the sequence of drifting away from God? It was described as first sin, then unbelief; when you quit behaving, you quit believing. How have you seen this play out in your life?
7. Do you have the tendency to talk about someone or talk to someone?
8. What does it mean to encourage **"daily"**?
9. Which word/phrase describes how you feel about going to someone, who is drifting?
  - A. Awkward
  - B. It's none of my business
  - C. That would be hypocritical
  - D. It is something God calls me to do.
10. Pray for:
  - A. The courage to encourage if you see someone drifting away from God.
  - B. The receptivity if someone "encourages" you.
