2. What is the first word that comes to your mind knowing God wants you to forgive, accept, care, encourage and submit to other people?

3. Read Ephesians 5:21.
 - A. What is your reaction knowing God wants you to submit to others?
 - B. What is hardest for you about the idea of submitting?
 - C. Who is it hard for you to submit to? Why?

4. In Ephesians 5:21, it says to “Submit...out of reverence to Christ.” How does this help you in your understanding of submission?

5. Read Philippians 2:1-11. What do these verses say to you?
 - A. Paul mentions attitude in verse 5. What does attitude have to do with submission?
 - B. How would you describe the attitude of Jesus based on his actions in these verses?
 - C. What is one characteristic of Jesus’ attitude that you need to try to model?

6. The statement was made “It may sound strange, but we need to submit to one another, because in a way – Christ submitted to us.” How did Christ submit to us?

7. Try to answer yes or no to the following question: Out of respect for Jesus and respect for what he has done for all of us, would you be willing to put the needs of others ahead of your own whenever it is possible?

8. How should we differentiate between someone's needs and wants when it comes to submitting to one another?

9. What is one way you could try living out the idea of "submitting to one another" this week?

10. Pray, as a group, that people would see the face (FACES) of God in you this week.
