4. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-8, 54-58. What is Paul trying to convey about the resurrection in these verses?
5. During the 3 years of Jesus' ministry, Peter struggled with:
  - A. Speaking without thinking
  - B. Anger issues
  - C. Fear and insecurity

Which one is your greatest struggle?

6. After Jesus resurrection, Peter seems to go from ordinary to extraordinary where he is willing to be bold and die for the Gospel.
  - A. Read 2 Peter 1:3
  - B. What changed in Peter's life to make him bold and willing to die for the Gospel?
7. Do you believe His grace is more powerful than your sin, or is your sin more powerful than His grace?
8. Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-11. What has changed in the Corinthian's lives?
9. What do you think of the statement "we win through surrender"?

10. What holds you back from surrendering everything as a Jesus follower?

11. As a group, share the areas where people are “stuck” and pray that God would heal, bring change and that the Holy Spirit would give courage to make progress.
