6. Read Ephesians 4:1 and 5:3. What do these verses have to say about integrity?
7. 4 challenges were given in regards to integrity: 1) Do you want to be a person of integrity; 2) Be ruthlessly honest with yourself; 3) Create some boundaries; 4) Create some accountability.
 - A. Which question or statement from numbers 1-4 above needs your greatest attention?
 - B. Share one action item that your need to take regarding the number your chose.
