4. Read Job 35:6-8; Psalms 50:7-13; Acts 17:24-25. What do these verses say regarding the topic "A God Who Doesn't Need Our Praise?"
5. Read Exodus 3:1-14. How does God describe himself to Moses? Why?
6. In Genesis 1:26-27, it states that "God created man in his image." What does it mean to you to know that you are created in God's image?
7. Because we are created in the image of God, we tend to love the things God loves. What are some things that God loves that you ought to love?
8. When you see something awe-inspiring, does it cause you to want to praise the Creator of all things? What do you need to do to make praising the Creator of all things a primary response in your life?
