WELCOME TO OUR SOLOIST, ANGELA BONELLO! Angela is passionate about using her voice to spread joy. She was recently awarded three prizes in the National 2026 George Shirley Vocal Competition, including the Soprano Prize and the Contemporary Art Song Prize, and she was awarded the First Place Charlotte Ruppel Memorial Voice Award through the Birmingham Musicale (2024). She was awarded First Place in the Neapolitan Song Vocal Competition at the University of Michigan (2026), and was one of five recipients of the 2026 Earl V. Moore Awards, earning her the privilege of performing an aria at the University of Michigan SMTD commencement ceremony. Angela's concert soloist experience includes Handel's Messiah, Fauré's Requiem, and Bach's Magnificat. Operatic roles include Susanna (Le nozze di Figaro), Papagena (The Magic Flute), Lucy (The House on Mango Street), Witch 1 (Working for the Macbeths), Sister Constance (Dialogues of the Carmelites), Patience (Patience), and

Despina (Così fan tutte). Angela has participated in performance outreach with the Motor City Lyric Opera (MCLO), created the role of Beth the Butterfly in a workshop of a new anti-bullying children's opera with the MCLO, and sings with multiple seasonal vocal ensembles at Greenfield Village in Dearborn. Angela earned her Bachelor of Music in Vocal Performance and Music Education from Oakland University in 2022, and in May 2026 graduated with her Master of Music degree in Voice & Opera Performance from the University of Michigan, where she studied with Caitlin Lynch. Beginning this Fall, she will continue her studies in the Artist Diploma program with a teaching assistantship at the University of Colorado Boulder.
