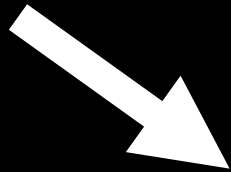

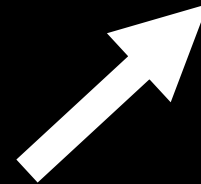

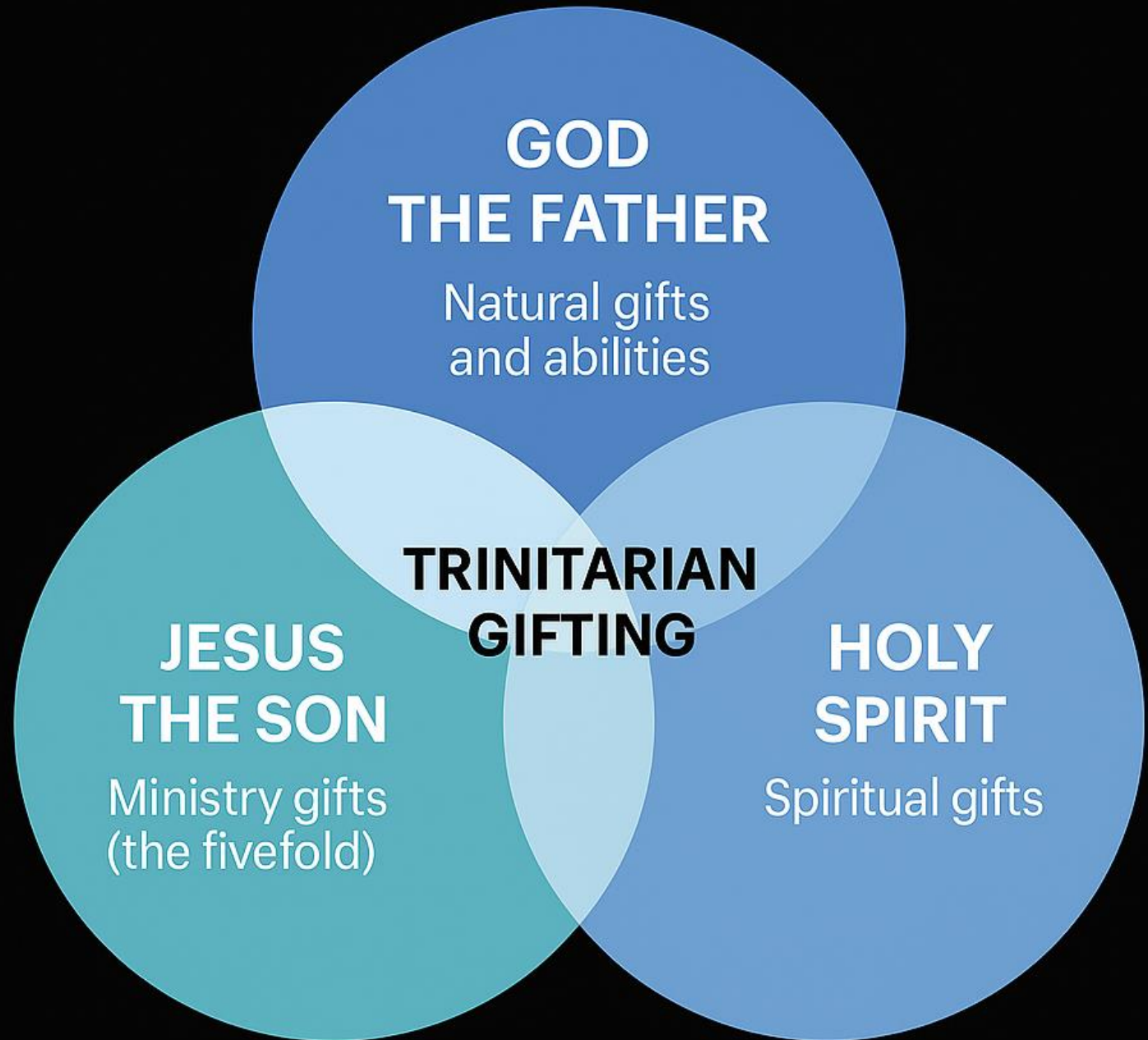
- All the colours of God's wisdom

Abraham and Sarah Gen 12

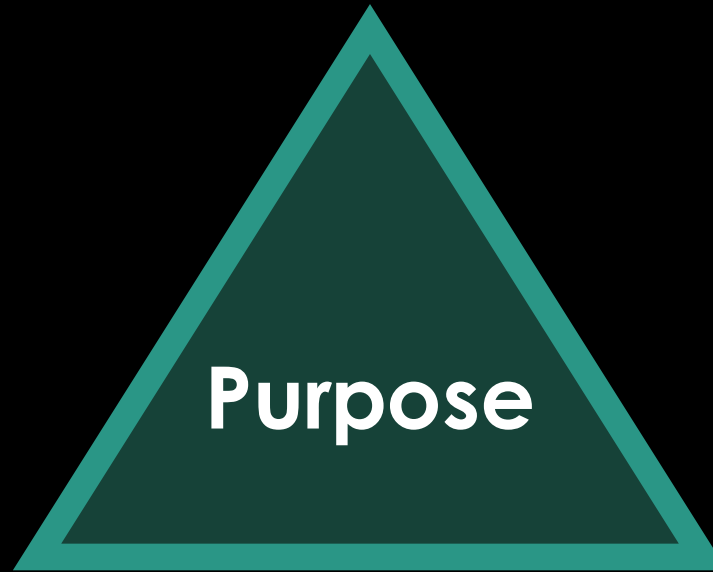
God **invites** them into a **partnership** in which their **dreams** for their lives become **woven together** with God's dream for the world

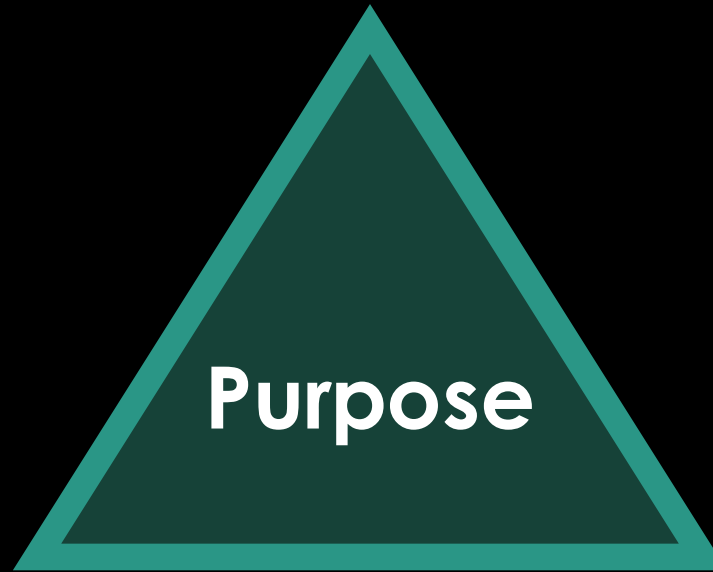
