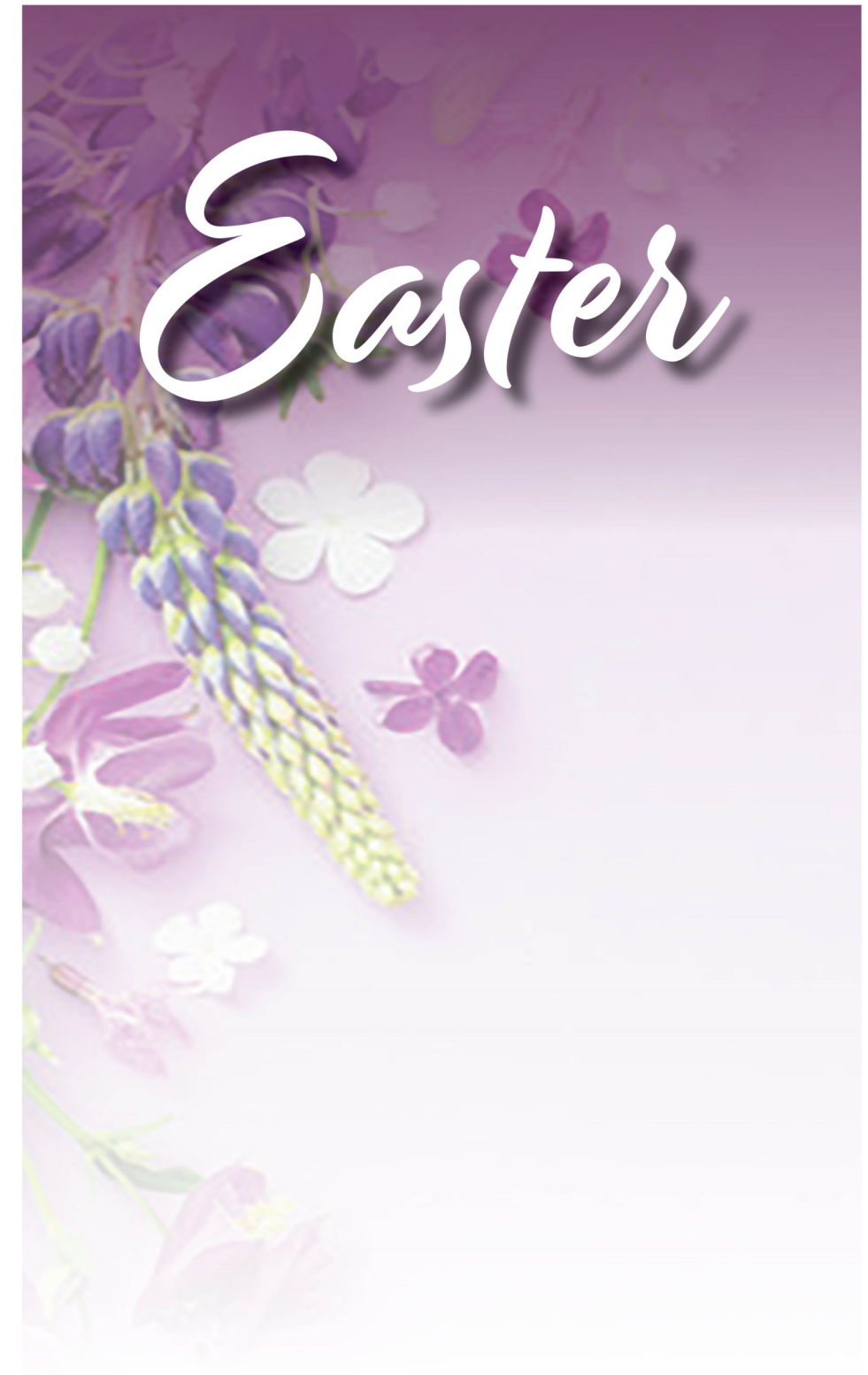
Register for VBS/BLAST Camp
