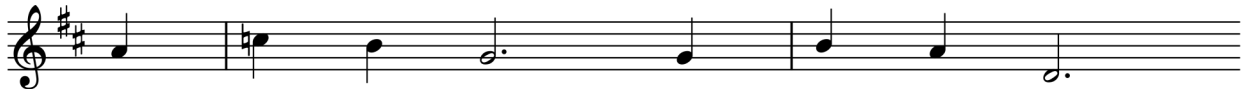
# My Song Is Love Unknown
