John 20:19-21

Every follower of Jesus is _____.

On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being locked where the disciples were for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you." John 20:19-21 (ESV)

CONNECT QUESTIONS

Breaking Ground

1. If you were free to do whatever you wanted, how would you spend your next rainy Saturday?
2. Briefly tell about a time when you acted as a minister and you could tell that God was at work in the situation. How did that experience feel to you?

Digging Deeper

1. Read Ephesians 4:7-15. According to this passage, what is the purpose of church leaders? How does this compare with what you have previously heard or seen?

What are the results of all church members doing their part? What if they don't? (answer based on this passage and on your experience in church)

2. Read 1 Corinthians 12:4-11 and Colossians 3:23-24. In your own experience, have you seen a "pecking order" for ministries? Based on these verses, what do you think Paul would say about that? What are the practical implications of your answer?
3. Read 1 Corinthians 12:31, 13:13 and Romans 12:9-17. Paul follows his discussion of spiritual gifts with instructions on acting in love in both 1 Corinthians and Romans. What are some dangers of emphasizing gifts while forgetting about love?

Read Philippians 2:1-11. What does this passage say about our call to serve in love?
