

3:22 GOD ALLOWS U-TURNS


God allows u-turns. Don't think it is too late to turn things around.

JESUS: A REAL PERSON

- Luke 1:1-4 Inasmuch as many have undertaken to compile a narrative of the things that have been accomplished among us, ² just as those who from the beginning were eyewitnesses and ministers of the word have delivered them to us, ³ it seemed good to me also, **having followed all things closely** for some time past, to write an orderly account for you, **most excellent Theophilus**, ⁴ that you may have certainty concerning the things you have been taught.

- Tacitus-“Christus, from whom the name [Christian] had its origin, suffered the extreme penalty during the reign of Tiberius at the hands of one of our procurators, Pontius Pilate...”
- Josephus-“James, the brother of Jesus who is called Christ...”

- **Pliny the Younger-Christians “sing hymns to Christ as to a god...”**
- **Lucian of Samosata-“The Christians... worship a man to this day—the distinguished personage who introduced their novel rites, and was crucified on that account.”**
- **Babylonian Talmud-“Jesus was executed on the eve of Passover”**

- Supernatural birth (Matthew 1:18-25)
- Wisdom (Matthew 13:54, Mark 6:2, Matthew 7:28–29, John 7:46, Colossians 2:2–3, Luke 20:23-26)
- Miracles (John 21:25)
- Sinless (2 Corinthians 5:21, 1 John 3:5, 1 Peter 2:22)
- Raised from the dead



JESUS: GOD

- His very nature (Philippians 2:5-6)
- Jesus accepted worship (Matt. 14:33; 28:9; John 8:38)
- The Father says to worship him (Hebrews 1:6)
- Alpha and Omega (Revelation 1:8; 22:13-16)
- Mighty God (Isaiah 9:6; 10:20-21)
- Used “I AM” as himself (John 8:48-59)
- Asserted himself as “Son of God” (John 5:18)

JESUS: A MAN

- Incarnate (Philippians 2:5-7)
- Hungry, tired, thirsty, sleepy (Mathew 44:2, John 44:6, 19:28; Mark 4:38)
- Human compassion (Matthew 9:36)
- Tender (Matthew 12:20)
- Loving (John 13:1)



JESUS: THE CHRIST

- Son of God (John 1:34)
- God's anointed King and Messiah (Matt. 16:13-20, Luke 19:36-40, Matthew 21:9)


JESUS: THE SUFFERING SERVANT

- Divine King/ Suffering Servant (Isaiah 9:6-7; 53:4-6, 11)
- Gave his life as a ransom for many (Matt. 20:28)
- Took away the sin of the world (John 1:29)



JESUS: ALIVE

- Empty tomb (Mark 16:5-6)
- The hinge of Christianity (1 Corinthians 15:14-19)
- Turned cowardly, skeptical men into martyrs

REPENT & BELIEVE



REPENTANCE

- Confess our sin (Psalm 51:3-4)
- Turn from sin (Proverbs 28:13)
- Turn to God (Jeremiah 33:3, 9:24; John 5:39)
- Bear fruit over time (Matthew 3:8)

REPENTANCE

- Why discuss repentance?
 - Jesus did
 - Luke 24:46–47 “Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, ⁴⁷ and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem.
 - “Repent” ~50 times in the New Testament
- Repentance alone is not sufficient

BELIEVE

- Faith, trust
- Action vs. Works
 - (Galatians 2:16, Ephesians 2:8-9)
- Actions associated with trust
 - (Mark 1:15; Romans 10:13, 9; Ephesians 2:8-9; John 1:12, 3:14-15; Acts 4:12)


SENSE OF URGENCY

- We don't know when Jesus will return
 - Matthew 25:1-13; Luke 12:35-40
- Death can come at any time
 - James 4:14; Proverbs 27:1
- Also use a true story of a person in the community that recently died.

“SINNER’S PRAYER”

- Sinners talking to God is 100% necessary
- Entrust them to God
- Pray for them
- Teach them to look for the fruits of the Holy Spirit



Don't worry about the accident. I have a message for you. (Okay)

God's judgement is coming, and the Bible says that we're all sinners. Do you know that you're a sinner? (Yes)

Good. Sinners are going to go to hell, but Jesus died for us on the cross, so we don't have to go to hell, and he rose from the dead 3 days later. Deep down in your heart, do you truly believe that? (Yes)

Then I want to encourage you to repent and trust in Jesus as your Lord and Savior.

Pray to God. Ask for forgiveness. Let him know that you believe in all that Jesus did for you and that Jesus is Lord.

Hi, my name is Cyril. Can I talk to you about Jesus for a few minutes? (Yes). Great Let's go through these verses together. I'll go first.

"...if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." Romans 10:9

"For the wages of sin is death (JUDGEMENT, HELL), but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 6:23

"but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8 (WOULD YOU DIE?; John 3:16)

"He is not here, for he has risen, as he said. Come, see the place where he lay." Matthew 28:6 (RESURRECTION STORIES)

Jesus said, "repent and believe in the gospel." Mark 1:15
(CHRISTMAS PRESENT; REPENTANCE, BELIEVE = TRUST
EXAMPLES)

"...if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."
Romans 10:9 (Romans 10:9-10)


I want to encourage you to pray to God. Ask for forgiveness. Let God know that you believe in all that Jesus did for you and that Jesus is Lord.


