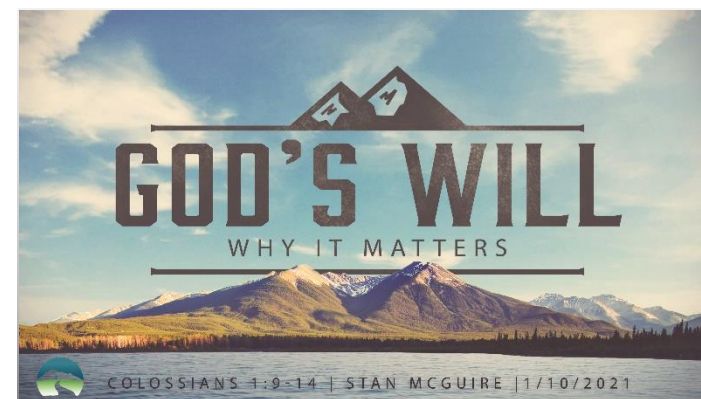

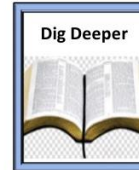

Encourage each other by sharing how God has either answered a prayer or worked in your life this past week.  
How has God challenged you through this week's message/passage? What impacted you?



Read Col. 1:3-8. How did Paul describe the Colossians? What had he heard about them/what sort of people were they? Since Epaphras was Paul's spiritual child, then the Colossians were his spiritual grandchildren. Can you hear a grandpa's pride toward them in his voice?

Whatever the full extent of the problems they were facing, Paul believed the solution was a knowing God and knowing Christ. Read Col 1:15-20. This is jam-packed with truth concerning the person and work of Jesus.

Read Col 1:21-23. Paul shifted his focus to include us. Describe who we were/who we are in relation to what He's done. What was his purpose (vs.22)? What was his admonition, and its implications (vs.23)?



### Action Plan – Point to Ponder:

Go back and read through Col 1:15-20 one verse at a time and unpack what you find. Explore the inexhaustible richness of who Jesus is and what He has done for us.
