Matthew 18:1-10

Big Idea: What does success look like in His kingdom? And what happens when we try to succeed the world's way?

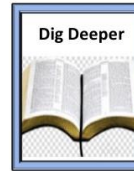
Success comes from dependence not self-promotion. (vv. 1-5)

Success the world's way harms those living dependent upon God. (vv. 6-10)

LIFE GROUP GUIDE



For the next 8 weeks, we encourage your group to watch "The Chosen." We are currently on week 3. Each week's sermon corresponds with the next episode in Season 1. Find out how to watch, go to: <http://lzymtn.com/chosen>



Jesus flips the concept of "greatness" upside-down! Read Matt 18:1-4. What is our first step to "greatness" (vv. 3-4)? According to vs. 5, what is the next step?

Read Mk 9:33-37. What does that passage add to the mix? In the midst of Jesus continually demonstrating His own humility, His disciples continually think of elevating themselves. How do you find this true in your own life? Where do your attitudes and actions fail to reflect this humbleness as described here by Jesus?

Read Matt 18:6-7. What sense do you take away from vs. 6? In vs. 7 describe both "woes." Read vv. 8-9. Does Jesus literally mean for people to dismember themselves? Would it still be possible to sin if we cut off both hands and both feet and plucked out both eyes? What is Jesus getting at? What's the attitude or principle He's driving toward?



Action Plan – Point to Ponder:

Read Matt 18:10-14. "Little ones" does not refer to physical children here but rather to those who come to Him in childlike humility. How does He describe His Father's attitude toward them? Re-read Matt 18:5 and Mark 9:37. As you pray this week ask the Lord to 1) help you to come to Him as a child, 2) receive His children as He does. May our hearts mirror His as we look at others.
