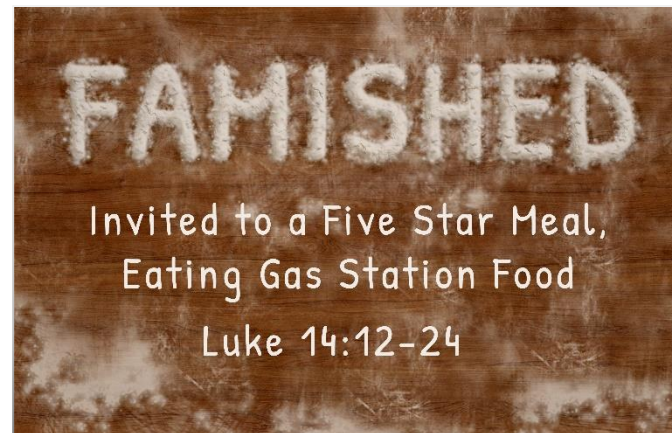

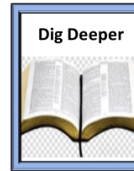

## LIFE GROUP GUIDE



How have you seen God work in your life this week?  
How has God challenged you through this week's message/passage? What impacted you?



The "Big Idea" from this week's message was, *"Our spiritual hunger can only be fulfilled by a relationship with God."*

Why do we so naturally resist this relationship? In John 3:16-21 Jesus lays out the foundation for this relationship (vv.16-18), then explains our typical response (vv.19-21).

Even as believers we still ignore this relationship. Read Matt 6:1-4, 5-6, 16-18. What was the negative attitude? How do we, as believers, stumble in this area?

How can we nurture our relationship with God? Read John 15:4-5. What is the one key word? What does it mean? In the example of the vine and the branches, who is the vine, and who are the branches? What does the branch actually have to do to provide fruit? How can we tangibly live this out in our daily lives, incorporate it into our day-to-day routines?



### Action Plan:

God so radically loves you! He wants what is absolutely best for you! This week read through, and meditate on, John 15:4-5. Ask the Holy Spirit to encourage you to simply spend some time abiding in Christ. Pray for each other that you would all experience a deeper relationship with Christ.
