**Follow the Leader: Faith Creates a Legacy
Hebrews 11:8-19**

Big Idea: When our lives do not turn out the way we thought they would, we are tempted to lose our faith. What misunderstandings do we have about faith that we can clarify in order to leave a legacy of faith?

Faith does not preview plans; it calls us to act on a promise (v. 8).

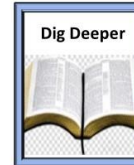
Faith does not force blessing but waits as God redefines blessing (vv. 9-11).

Faith does not receive all promises now, but the promises received testify what is to come (vv.12-16).

LIFE GROUP GUIDE



Encourage each other by sharing how God has either answered a prayer or worked in your life this past week.
How has God challenged you through this week's message/passage? What impacted you?



Heb 11:8 starts with, "By faith Abraham obeyed." Read the following passages in Genesis: 12:1-4; 13:14-18; 15:1-6. Discuss his obedience. What does Gen 15:6 add to this?
God had promised the land to Abraham. Yet he never fully took possession of the land in his lifetime. He lived there as a foreigner (Heb 11:9-10).

Read Heb 11:11. What does it say about Sarah? Note that even though God gave the power, she had to "receive" it. Why was she able to receive it (last phrase)? Discuss this.

The result of Abraham and Sarah's faith is found in verse 12, which correlates with Gen 15:5 and 13:16.

For further reading: Read Romans 4 and Galatians 3. Read the whole chapters but pay special attention to Rom 4:23-25 and Gal 3:13-14. Who is the Promise? Have fun unpacking these chapters! There's a lot in there!



Action Plan – Point to Ponder:
Read Heb 11:13-16. This caps off "Abraham: Part 1." Note verse 16b, "Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God." Rarely think about God being ashamed of us. Spend some time this week meditating on Abraham's faith. He believed and obeyed. Sarah received because of her faith. What is God asking you to trust Him for? Pray for strength to believe and obey, that you might receive what He has promised.
