Ministry teams are requested to get their reports in one week prior to the Session meeting which normally meets on the third Tuesday of each month.


• Elder Weston, as church treasurer, requested additional helpers to serve as money counters.



Our group may assist in children's programming at a local youth center, care for the elderly by helping with outdoor yard projects, or sort donations at a food pantry. In the evenings, we will visit local attractions like Canal Park and Park Point Beach. YouthWorks has partnered with this community since 1998.

Dates: June 23 - June 28 (Sunday-Friday)

Cost: \$525 (or \$500 with early deposit)

Why: To ignite a passion for serving God, serving others and to see how God is at work in your life.
