"An Appointment You Can't Afford to Miss!" Part II

The Need for a Specialist Prayer

Sunday's sermon was a Part II to "An Appointment You Can't Afford to Miss!" from the text Luke 11:1-13; the disciples observe Jesus praying and ask Him, "Lord, teach us to pray" (Luke 11:1). Jesus responds with the Lord's Prayer (Luke 11:2-4), showing us how to connect with God on a personal level. Just like we seek specialists for important health issues, our prayer life needs that same urgency, especially when life gets challenging. In verses 5-8, Jesus shares a parable about a friend who knocks on his neighbor's door at midnight, asking for bread to help another friend in need. This story teaches the importance of being persistent in our prayers—the friend's boldness shows the urgency of a request that simply cannot wait, as it was required hospitality in biblical times to take care of visitors.

Persistent Boldness in Prayer

When we come to God in prayer, we need to exercise the same boldness and perseverance as the friend in the parable. The friend who knocked at midnight wasn't just asking for himself; he was reaching out because a friend had a need that couldn't wait. Initially, the homeowner was reluctant to accommodate this late-night request, thinking it was too inconvenient. However, because of the friend's persistence and determination, he eventually gave in and provided the bread needed. The story reminds me of how we sometimes try to reach someone who has their phone set to "Do Not Disturb," "Sleep Mode," or "Focus Mode." Those notifications often indicate that the person isn't readily available, but there's usually an option to "Notify Anyway," which signifies that the urgency of our message matters—and the message goes through instead of being delayed. Just like that option to notify someone despite their settings, Jesus is our "Notify Anyway." He's always available, ready to hear us, and never ignores or denies our calls for help, no matter the urgency.

The Appointment of ASK

Jesus invites us to Ask, Seek, and Knock (Luke 11:9-10). This isn't just a suggestion but an open invitation to come to Jesus actively in prayer. When we ask confidently, we participate in God's work, whether it's a prayer for our own needs or whether we're standing in intercessory prayer for others. Jesus hears and responds according to His will for our lives.

Boldness in Prayer

Scripture encourages us to approach God's throne with boldness (Hebrews 4:16). Our persistent prayers demonstrate our faith that God will respond to our needs. Just as a specialist physician prescribes an advanced treatment plan, God responds to our sincere requests with the direction and purpose we need for our lives.

Jesus: The Key to Our Connection

Ultimately, Jesus is the key that unlocks our relationship with God. He invites us to bring our needs and concerns directly to Him, reminding us that we are never alone in our struggles. By seeking Him first, we can find the guidance, strength, and healing we need. So, don't ever give up on your healing, deliverance, purpose, and prayers! Let's embrace this appointment of prayer, confident that through Jesus, our "Notify Anyway," we can boldly approach the Father and receive His grace. Amen.
