Let God Speak...Second Chances, Part II

In the third part of the Jonah series, The Power of Second Chances," Jonah finally reaches dry land after being in the belly of a fish and a storm sent by God because of his disobedience. Jonah is now in Nineveh, enemy territory, to deliver a message of repentance. This opportunity for a fresh start is not only for the Assyrians of Nineveh but also for Jonah himself, who harbored resentment, and understandably so. However, our human frailties must not overthrow our obedience to God.

Jonah's arrival on dry land marks the beginning of his preaching the message of repentance to the people of Nineveh. The message expounded on the second chance for Jonah, who strayed away from God, and the Ninevites, who were never on God's path. However, Jonah struggles with letting go of the pain, trauma, and loss inflicted by the Assyrians. His reluctance to forgive leads him down a path of sin and spiritual sickness. We, too, must face our "enemy" internally and externally, however God leads us.

The story of Jonah leads us to reflect on our own acts of disobedience towards God and the unkindness and unfairness projected onto us by others and how we've projected it onto others. The powerful aspect of God's nature is that we are not condemned to live a life of ungodliness, stagnation, and defiance. We are given second chances to receive blessings, to get it right, to receive forgiveness, and to extend the same to others, even to our enemies. Jonah received a second chance, and he got it right.

During the sermon, I asked the question of whether we would want our enemies to be blessed. Some hands went up, while others did not. We kept it real, and it was powerful to witness the genuine responses of God's people, as we acknowledged our strengths and areas for growth (James 5:16). The church is a safe space for introspection, to confront our imperfections, and to strive for progress in overcoming our struggles. (Thessalonians 2:13) It was a profound moment and worship experience, with the Holy Spirit moving freely and prophetic words being spoken. I am still filled with a sense of spiritual elevation and inspiration, as we worshipped and gave thanksgivings to God for his love, grace and mercy extended to us. I pray you, too, may feel the same experience!
