In order to abide by the stay-at-home orders that are in place, we will not be able to finish out the school year. We will not be able to make those plans until stay-at-home orders are lifted. Once that happens, we will post that information on Facebook and in our apps.

Many of you have had questions regarding tuition payments. We wanted to give you the following information:

1. No tuition will be due for April or May.
2. Those parents who have already paid for April/May will receive a credit or refund. I will be contacting each of those families over the next week with details.
3. Students in a 2 or 3 day class will not receive a refund for any days in March. Per our policy, we were able to use our delay/cancellation days to cover the days we missed.
4. Students in the 4 and 5 day classes did not have enough remaining delay days to cover the entire month of March, so they will receive a credit/refund for the remaining days.
