REOPENING GUIDELINES - JUNE 7, 2020

As of Sunday, June 7 Life Church Meridian is now meeting in person with Sunday services at 8:30 & 10:30, and (as of Sept. 9) Wednesday night Small Groups at 6:30.

We are enjoying being able to see everyone and talk face to face, while still respecting safety protocols for Covid-19.

We will take every precaution to assure your safety. However we also support those who are vulnerable, at-risk or feel more comfortable worshipping at home and encourage you to do so for now. We will be continuing the Facebook Live broadcasts Sunday at 10:30 a.m.

Please do not attend in-person services or Small Groups if you are sick, symptomatic, have a family member that is sick, or if you have recently been exposed to COVID-19. We encourage those who are immunocompromised, not in good health, or in a high-risk group to attend online instead of in-person.

We will be observing the following the guidelines:

- Greeters will be stationed at the front doors to assist you and open the doors for you. We encourage the use of face masks until you are seated and as you leave the building. We encourage you to wear your own mask, but there will be some available upon request. We ask children age 3 and up to wear masks until seated in their KidsZone classes.
- Please maintain 6ft social distancing and greet each other with smiles, waves, or air hugs.
- Seating will be arranged with 6 feet between families or singles. Our sanctuary which has a seating capacity of 190 people will be limited to half capacity. If needed, we will use the Fellowship Hall for overflow seating.
- Our KidsZone childrens ministry area is now open for babies thru kids in 5th grade. Our Guidelines for the KidsZone can be found here: <https://bit.ly/LCM-KidsZone>. Please talk with your children prior to attending and help them understand the safety protocols. Please watch your children and keep them with you when they are not in the KidsZone. The "Cry Room" will be available for moms and babies that need to exit the service for any reason.
- All of the areas where we gather, including restrooms, will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized before and between services. There will be hand sanitizer available next to the entrance to the sanctuary and on the Welcome Desk.
- We will not be serving coffee for the time being. Please refrain from using water fountains. We encourage fellowship, but please do so outside of the building where everyone can better maintain distancing.
- There will be ushers just outside the sanctuary door after the service with baskets for offerings and Connect Cards. Please bring your own pen to use for Connect Cards and Offering Envelopes.

Our desire is for everyone to be safe as we meet to worship together. We will take this week by week and notify you of any changes.
