You will hear her speak about the lessons she learned through those years as life came crashing down.

She has been known for over 42 years as a musician with 19 albums. She is also the writer of six books. She's been nominated for a Dove Award and long admired for her ability to communicate to an audience. She is an artist with words and her poetic bent is evident in whatever she touches.

Christine loves stories. When she was four years old, she used to put on a pair of red glasses. She would tell her friends, who also couldn't read yet, that her glasses were special as she pretended that her red plastic glasses would enable her to read any book. She couldn't read a word, mind you.

But, she wove stories by the hour while her friends listened in contentedly. Later, she would learn that most of Jesus' sermons were stories.

Today, she still believes that stories are effective because they provide a way for truth to enter through a back door to a person's heart.

....Change the spiritual dynamics of every woman daring enough to take her message to heart. Many christian women *think* they know what it is to be God's child. They may even know a lot of scripture and significant amounts of doctrine. However, many admit that they just aren't connected to God experientially. Sadly, the result is often anger and confusion. Christine knows. She's been there.

....Present scripture as the living revelation of God rather than as an abstract textbook. Christine's teaching makes scripture jump off the page. Many have said that they heard God's voice for the first time. Their hunger for the Word is awakened out of a deep sleep.

....Proclaim a message that is simple, yet radical, through teaching and music. Christine's music cements the teaching it in the hearts of the women. Many say that the *Daughters of Promise* day became the 'first day of the rest of their lives.' Discipleship is understood and deeply desired as a result of this conference.

Where's Your Samuel?

Hannah was desperate and made an outrageous vow to God regarding a future child. Samuel was born. Each of us has a kind of 'Samuel' in us; something waiting to be born out of great adversity. Most never discover their future is in the redemption of past pain. Do you know what yours is? **35 min.**

What Would Jesus Do?

You probably remember the bracelet bearing the name of this session. It's helpful for us to know how Jesus handled different people so we can gain insight on how to handle people who are similar. How did He navigate religious phonies or those who wore a stigma? How did He relate to His enemy, Satan? How did He function in relationship with His father? Peek into the life of Jesus in new ways. **1 hour**

The Fuel of the Spirit

Oftentimes, the fire that once burned in our heart goes out. Living without passion is monotonous, and tragic, and the opposite of what God intended. The devil is trying to douse the flames but here's what God wants us to know. Jesus is praying for us and He waits to throw accelerant on the fire. **45 min.**

Suffering and Sovereignty

Is God sovereign over all the bad things that happen to us? Is He the author of it? Why does He permit it? How do suffering and the sovereignty of God intersect? Find new strength in the character and plans of a loving God. **1 hour**

Who Is My Storyteller?

Each of us has had storytellers in our lives. They shaped us; stories told by parents, grandparents, cousins, teachers, pastors, bullies. They told us things about ourselves that still feel true and control our lives. How can we sort it all out and discover God's version of our own unique story? **1 hour**

Springboard Prayers

Many find that their prayer lives are dull and they don't know what to do to fix it. They often just pray scripture but that doesn't feel very personal to them. How can prayers springboard off scriptural passages? Find out how and see how powerful and personal prayer can be. **45 min.**

The Samaritan Woman

Jesus broke all the rules of gender and racial lines when he intentionally encountered the woman of Samaria. In one short conversation, she emerged from the shadows of hopelessness to experience wonder, love, and joy. Is there something to learn from her that will make our relationship with Jesus come to life? **45 min.**

Peter ~ A 2nd Look

A beloved disciple. A powerful apostle. Yet, still stigmatized in sermons across the world. Are we too tough on Peter? It's worth taking a second look at this biblical hero and by doing so, we find ourselves in him. Flawed but chosen. Often disqualified by men but made worthy by God to affect history. **45 min.**

Spiritual Orphans

We are much-loved daughters of Abba and yet each of us still lives as a spiritual orphan in at least one way. Christine shares 10 profile characteristics of a spiritual orphan and uses the stories of her own life as examples. She challenges you to see how many describe *your* life. **1 hour**

Orphans to Daughters

This is the second half to Spiritual Orphans. Learn to live as a daughter instead. Christine finishes this series by sharing 10 profile characteristics of God's daughter. Step into new kingdom slippers. **1 hour**

Long Live The King

Forgiveness is a much misunderstood topic. There are many myths surrounding it. How do I know if I've forgiven? Partially, or completely? What are the roadblocks that make forgiveness so difficult? And is there a template that will help me begin, persevere, and complete the forgiveness process? Yes, and it's all found in this session. "Forgiveness" like you've never heard it before. Some say it was the most powerful part of the day. **75 min.**

Living As A Daughter Of Promise

It's easy to say that I'm a daughter of promise, but what does it look like for me to live like one? What does God expect from me? Sometimes I feel guilty for not doing enough. Where can I find spiritual rest and where is it safe to live authentically? Learn how to connect with the heart of God, learn to hear His whispers of love, and then learn to thrive in a world that inflicts shame and self-doubt. Tired of living life out of the grind? Live energized by the heart of God. **1 hour**

Justification

Such a weighty term. And, it sounds dry - like a doctrinal class you'd take in seminary. Ah, but it's not. Learn what it means when God calls you justified. Feel the impact of God's forgiveness and Jesus' gift of righteousness. This session will deepen the meaning and appreciation of your new birth. **1 hour**

Integrating Daughters Into Real Life

How does a daughter of God integrate her faith into real life? How does she navigate the storms of family rejection? Of marital dis-harmony? Of children who reject the faith? How does she live out her faith in a world that is growing more hostile to the Gospel? Bedrock application for every woman. **1 hour**

Yokes And The Burdens We Carry

Jesus said His yoke is easy and His burden is light. What does that really mean? And why doesn't it feel like that? Not only does this session explore that but it unveils five other yokes we often wear that eclipse the real one Jesus offers us. **1 hour**

Enjoying God ~ Is It Possible?

Christian catechism says that it is man's end to enjoy God and glorify Him forever. How sad to miss the very thing for which we were born. How does someone enjoy God? How do you? Learning how is to shake up one's spiritual life and put it on a different trajectory. **40 min.**

Help! This Person Is Drowning Me!

How do you handle the person who drains you to the core? Perhaps they're a whiner or just maybe their needs are legitimate. It's probably occurred to you that what you offer others usually satisfies but *this* person always wants more of you than you can give. You are suffering from the exhausting effects of those who are skilled at 'feeding' off of you instead of tapping into the resources of Christ. Learn how to re-structure the relationship. **1 hour**

Cultivation of a Disciple's Heart

Jesus' most well known parable is the one about the soil and the Sower. Christine unwraps each soil type and helps others see which type they possess. They learn to assess - and then gain the skills to change it to the kind that accepts heaven's seeds and prospers. **1 hour.**

Creative Soul Care

Giving other believers good soul care is a skill not often taught in the church. We pray our prayers, recite some verses, tell them everything is going to be okay, but is this what Jesus would do? Christine will give you 15 new encouragement skills that leave hurting people with the feeling that Jesus has touched their heart profoundly. **1 hour.**

7 Ways To Bring the Kingdom to Your Family

What would happen if the kingdom invaded your personal world? Isn't that exactly what Jesus taught us to pray when he expressed, 'Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done' in the Lord's prayer? Christine shows what happens when the kingdom comes to a house of conflict, or a divided marriage, or generations of people who are at odds with their faith. Don't miss it. **1 hour**
