Opportunities This Week

Because we've gotten questions about the International Women's Day, we also wanted to clarify the focus of March 7th and 8th. On a global scale, outside of the International Churches of Christ, the International Women's Day is a day to rally for women's rights and social change.

However, within our family of churches, we are seizing the opportunity to think bigger and make a more eternal impact. We invite you to use these two days to deepen their own personal relationships with our Father, which in turn will overflow into the community.

On March 7th, fast and pray for direction. Some suggestions on how to do this:

- **Be intentional.** Schedule specific time on March 7th to spend in prayer, a minimum of 30 minutes. Have them put this in their calendars now, to block this time

out for God. Then, continue to fast and pray as much as you are able to, throughout the day.

- **Get active.** Did you know exercise can boost creativity? Take a walk or run during your prayer time to help jumpstart inspiration. Plus, if you walk outside you can commune with God in nature!
- **Worship creatively.** If you have a longer amount of time for prayer and creative leanings, consider using your talents in your worship. Journal, doodle, paint, sculpt, sing, play an instrument...you might be surprised how God will use this time to inspire you!

On March 8th, take the first steps in putting into action what God has inspired you to do, as a woman of God leading other women to God. This will look different for each person, but some possibilities might include:

- Inviting a friend to Family Group/Bible Study.
- Finding a local charity that matches your passion, and figure out how you can help.
- Share your own unique dream with a friend to seek advice on how to make it a reality.
