28-Day Scripture Writing Plan: One Another!

God speaks to us through His Word, so commit to spending 10-15 minutes each day to write down these verses. Think and reflect on what God's Word is saying to you. Write down – and share – what you're learning.

"One another" is two words in English, but it's only one word in Greek: **ἀλλήλων** (*ah-LAY-loan*). The meaning is straightforward: "one another," "each other," referring to relationships of mutuality. In all cases, "one another" requires more than one person; and it often involves a group of people. To really grow spiritually in the ways God wants us to grow, we need **ἀλλήλων** —one another.
