Norman to Visit Casa Hogar, Honduras March 21-28

The pressing need to advance the legal aspects of the transition of the Casa Hogar ministry from Vida y Libertad in Spain to The Fellowship is a priority for this trip. Norman will be traveling with National Fellowship President, Steve Jones. Your prayers are coveted for a safe and prosperous trip. Norman will be meeting with a lawyer in Tegucigalpa, as well as in Siguatepeque, along with many others. The restrictions regarding travel are such that it appears possible to make this very overdue trip. Another goal is to lay out preliminary plans for the expansion of the ministry as the Lord provides. It will also be important to re-connect in person with our Fellowship International missionaries and Tina as director.

One of the major goals in the transition of the Casa Hogar ministry is to establish a new legal incorporation (like establishing a registered charity in Canada). This has the same challenges, or more, as we do in Canada.

Medellin Colombia—second stop March 29 to April 4

As you may recall Norman also volunteers as the one responsible for supervision of FAIR project management in Colombia and will continue on with Steve Jones to visit the ministries and projects in Medellin. It will be a wonderful opportunity to renew fellowship with long time servants of the Lord with which we had the privilege to serve many years ago as well as meet the many new ministry leaders.
