Expanding our engagement in fellowship with God's people in the church and around the world

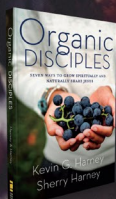

*There are always four generations of people
who are part of the journey of
Organic Discipleship:*

Generation 1:

Someone to influence me

*We all need more mature believers who are
part of our lives and helping us grow in the 7
markers of maturity.*

Generation 2:

I need to tend to my own growth

*We are each responsible to pay attention to
our own growth journey and keep taking steps
forward as we become more like Jesus.*

Generation 3:

Someone I am influencing to grow up in their faith

*We are each called to take the hand of
someone who we can help grow up in
Christlikeness.*

Generation 4:

We inspire and equip the people we influence to do the same with others

*We can equip those we influence spiritually
(disciple) to do the same with others.*

When we follow this simple and beautiful
biblical model we discover that generation
after generation of people learn to grow in
faith. Each believer takes the hand of
someone who helps them grow up in faith
and also the hand of someone who needs
to grow. As they take another hand, and
they take another hand, we climb the hill
of faith together and the world is
