Sermon Study Guide

Questions for family/small group discussions:

- What does it mean that eternal life is now and later? Read John 14:6-8, Rom. 5:5, John 14:27, 16:22, 17:22, 2 Cor. 3:18 – How does God's Spirit give us a taste of heaven and eternal life that is both now and later?
- 2. St. Augustine: "You have made us for yourself and our hearts are restless till they rest in you." What are the things or wrong places to which you have looked in your restless search for love, meaning and significance?
- 3. Read Jer. 9:23-24. Knowing God transforms us into the image of God and NOT knowing God leads us to transform God into an image of ourselves. Why would we want to change/adjust our view of who God is rather than have knowing him change us?
- 4. It was noted that the more we know God as he is truly revealed through Jesus, the more we will love and gladly serve him. What are the aspects or characteristics of God that most impact you toward loving and serving him?
- 5. Jesus suffered under the wrath of his Father so that you could be wonderfully received as a son or daughter. Jesus became utterly restless and lost his peace so that you could have eternal peace. How does knowing God make a difference for you through your anxious times and trials?
