

This month, we will be introducing a song by Sovereign Grace Music called *Glorious*.

Like most songs that come out of Sovereign Grace, this song is filled with such rich theological truths derived directly from scripture. What better way to guarantee that the songs we sing together are fitting for worship, than to pick songs that come from God's word!?

I love this song because it reminds us of the life of Christ, his humility, love, service, and ultimately the grace that we have in him. Verse 1 opens by reminding us of his humility (The King left His throne behind). Verse 2 reminds us of how he loved others, not only his friends, but strangers and even his enemies. Verse 3 reminds us of his willingness to suffer for the sake of the gospel, and finally the 4th verse reminds us of his power over death and our hope of new life through the resurrection.
