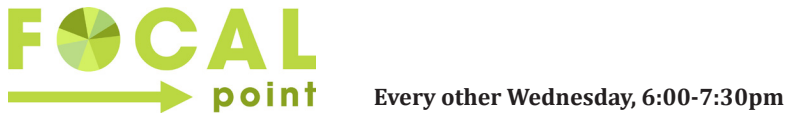
KidLife Worship is available for kids ages 3 years - K. Nursery is also available.
