- No open flames, fireworks, flammable liquids, etc as part of your trunk decorations

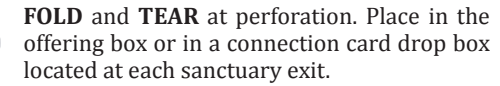
