MISSION: Empowering Christians to join Christ’s work in their community.

Volunteers In Service (VIS) works to place faith-based volunteers alongside of people who can use some help and/or support.

Services Available

- **Friendly Visitor** – a friend to visit 2-3 times a month, possibly more often if both the volunteer and person being visited agree. This will be done by someone of the same gender as the person they are visiting.
- **Housework** – help with occasional housekeeping (i.e. sweeping, mopping, vacuuming, dusting, cleaning bathrooms), laundry, etc. We are not able to help with preparation for extermination of pests.
- **Minor Home Repairs** – may include painting, drywall repair, handyman projects, and other small projects. Generally we are not able to repair/replace roofs, do exterior work on the second story, or do extensive repairs. The homeowner is asked to provide or pay for the supplies needed, if possible.
- **Mother’s Helper** – someone to help a young mom with chores, playing with children while mom has me to herself, and just being a supportive friend. Volunteers are not permitted to babysit; mom has to be in the house at all times.
- **Phone/Card Visitor** – a friend to phone or send cards 2-3 times a month.
- **Respite** – someone to sit with an adult who can not be left alone. Volunteers are not able to do any personal care, i.e. toileting or bathing, and they can stay for 2-3 hours.
- **Transportation** – take people to the grocery store, doctor, bank, pharmacy, etc. We need at least a two-week notice for medical appointments; 1-2 days for food pantry pick up or grocery store rides.
- **Yard Work** – mowing, raking, cleaning up, planting flowers, spreading mulch, or any other yard work that may be needed.
