## A PRIMER ON THE BOOK OF JAMES

Who: James, the half brother of Jesus

When: Sometime between 43-46 AD, before Paul's first missionary

journey. Likely the first NT book written.

To Whom: Jewish believers in Jesus scattered throughout the world

**Why:** To encourage believers to live out their faith in day-to-day life, not merely as a ritual or custom, but as deliberate acts of faith and worship. James writes with many references to the sermon on the mount and the book of Proverbs.


