This Advent, we're rooting ourselves in two anchor songs: "Emmanuel (Hallowed Manger Ground)" and "Is He Worthy?" Each week, we'll begin with Emmanuel and end with Is He Worthy—bookending our worship with the story we're living in: waiting in hope, and resting in the certainty that Christ is King. As our team sat with the themes of longing and expectation, we tried to find music that carried that tone. These songs rang true for us. They hold both sides of Advent in tension: the ache of a world that's not yet whole, and the steady truth that Jesus is worthy—yesterday, today, and forever.

We wait in the dark, but not without a King. Christ is worthy, and He will come again.

So please join us as we sing, and let these words shape your waiting. Lift your voice, remember the promise, and rest in the hope we share: |

The King is coming.

Open your mind, believe it.

Open your heart, receive Him.
