### **PRAYER OF CONFESSION**

God is worthy of our praise, but we are aware that we are undeserving of God's grace. Yet, God gives it to us anyway. This is why we can sing God's praises! So, in words, spoken and sung, let us lift our confessions to God:

Gracious God, you created all things good, yet we do not always live up to that goodness. In our time of confession, we come as we are – broken, sinful, hurtful – knowing that you will welcome us. So, together we sing:

Just as I am, without one plea but that thy blood was shed for me, and that thou biddest me come to thee, O Lamb of God, I come; I come!

Merciful God, we know the difference between right and wrong, yet sometimes feel powerless in the face of temptation.


