# Stewardship





Park Ridge Community Church organizes our financial assets into Funds and Accounts to ensure donor's wishes are honored, future ministries are provided for, and ongoing needs are met. Many of these funds were established by saints of the past, who generously gave knowing future generations would rely on what they set up. The Capital Replacement, Endowment, and Contingency Funds are all held at Northern Trust, where they are invested. In years when interest accrues, that interest is rolled into the General Fund to cover the costs of ministry.
