#### **PAST CAPITAL FUND PROJECTS**

Past use of the CRF includes: In 2022 - masonry work on the Great Hall and a new railing on stairs from Park Place Room; In 2021 - A/C in Associate's office, refurbishment of stained glass in Ellinger transept; In 2020 - exterior painting and outdoor drainage repair; and In 2019 - the Great Hall roof!



## **FUTURE PROJECTS**

The Trustees are compiling a list of future projects of varying urgency along with associated costs: everything from roofs and boilers to air conditioning and painting.


