



# PARK RIDGE COMMUNITY CHURCH CHRISTIAN OUTREACH & MISSION

PRCC Outreach Committee helps us to live out our commitments to loving our neighbors.

We partner with organizations with whom we can serve those in need, near and far. This year we have:

### **FED PEOPLE:**

- · Provided 480 dinners for the residents of Lincoln Park Shelter
- · 42 people volunteered at Feed My Starving Children
- Assembled 160 lunches every month since March = 1,440 lunches, distributed through Loving Lunches; Kindred Spirits Cafe' assembled Loving Lunches = 260 additional lunches
- · Sponsored an Eagle Scout Project building a Free food pantry onsite
- · Hosted 3 Sunday Night Suppers
- Delivered over 20 carloads of food items to the Maine Township Food Pantry
- · Walked in the Crop Walk with 38 participants, raising over \$10K
- · Provided grocery gift cards to persons in need

### **CLOTHED PEOPLE:**

- Collected 60 new pairs of boots for those experiencing homelessness, given through The Night Ministry
- Collected 115 Backpacks for migrant children with Maryville Academy
- Outfitted an entire apartment for a refugee family of <u>nine</u> through Exodus World Service; purchased new winter coats for the family
- Donated MANY handmade hats, scarves, blankets, toiletry bags, and 100 coats through The Bridge Project
- Back-to-School supplies/Backpacks collected & given through Jeanine Schultz School

### **EMERGENCY RESPONSE:**

- Supported a clothing closet for fire victims and donated to a relief fund that awarded \$200 per fire victim
- · Provided matching grants for Ukraine; raising over \$20,000
- Funded the "Community Emergency Needs" fund through the Ministerial Association held at police department
