

ISSM 2018
Short Term Mission Trip
to Roatan, Honduras
<<< June 16, 2018 – June 23, 2018 >>>

Please begin to pray about your opportunity to go on a short-term missions trip to partner with believers on the island of Roatan.

- Estimated cost of trip = \$1,800 per person which includes:
 - Airfare, Transportation each day, Accommodations (w/ tip), Food, Travel Insurance
 - \$100 non-refundable deposit due by Friday, March 9, 2018
 - Remaining \$1,700 due by Saturday, May 12, 2018
- Other Misc Expenses:
 - Offerings; as we will be visiting 3 churches (optional)
 - Eating out; approx \$50 (optional)
 - Personal Drinks & Snacks (optional)
 - Donations to needs; of which there are many (optional)
 - Activities on off-day \$40 - \$60 (optional)
- Accommodations while in Roatan:
 - We will be staying at Casa Isabella. This is a nice 5 bedroom house right on the beach whose owner caters to mission groups.
 - It can accommodate 20 people.
 - All of our meals will be prepared at the house (we may eat out once or twice)
 - *** Anyone with food allergies will need to let us know ***
 - Casa Isabella will provide transportation to all of our outings via a 20 passenger bus.
- Who Can Go:
 - There are 20 spots available for this trip
- Paying for the Trip
 - There will be Fundraiser opportunities throughout the year
 - You are encouraged to send out support letters to help pay for the trip
- We will provide a suggested packing list
- We suggest that people speak to their family doctor regarding any recommended shots or other precautions.

- Passports:
 - Anyone without a Passport should send in their application **immediately**
 - Any current Passports **MUST** be valid through December 2018. Honduras requires that all Passports must have 6 month validity from time of travel.
- About the mission opportunity:
 - The main focus of our trip will be prayer. We will have the opportunity to pray and encourage local pastors as well as those in the community that have needs.
 - For those who are comfortable speaking in front of a group, we hope to have the opportunity to share in several churches.
 - We will be visiting a boy's orphanage to help in any way that we can.
 - We will visit a number of public elementary schools to share Jesus and encourage them to stay in school. This could include skits, games, Bible study, etc.
 - Will help a local ministry that serves a meal to 150 elementary children every week. (cook, serve, and clean up)
 - Spanish is the primary language, but there are many local people who know English.
