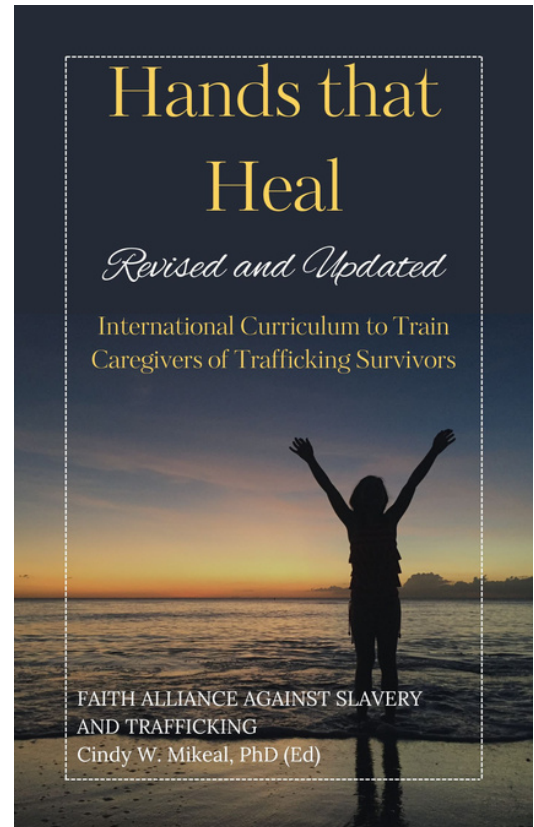


Hands that Heal Revision

Join FAAST

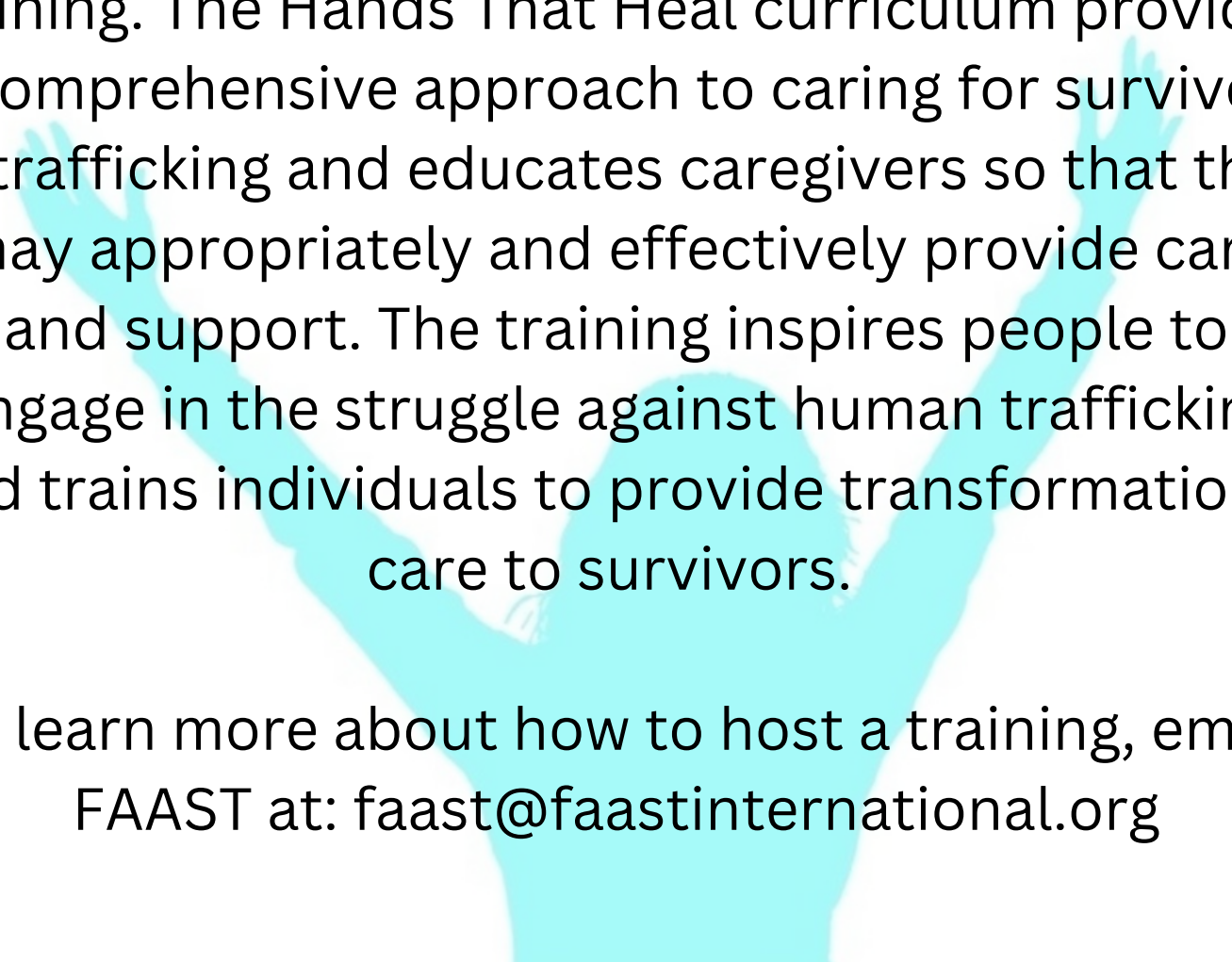
