To the Members, Regular Attendees and Visitors of Salado United Methodist Church:

On Thursday, November 19, 2020, the Salado United Methodist Church Leadership was officially notified of multiple cases of COVID-19 exposure among the staff and immediate family members. In addition, several regular attendees of the church have also tested positive for COVID-19. In accordance with the CDC and Bell County Health Department guidelines, those in close contact with staff members have been contacted.

In consultation with the South District Superintendent and other Annual Conference leaders, as well as our own COVID Leadership Team and Bell County Health Department, the following are the measures to protect our congregation and staff:

- The office will be closed beginning Friday, November 20, 2020 indefinitely while the necessary quarantine/self-isolation periods are observed. We will notify the church once a date has been set for a safe reopening.
- In-person Church services for Sunday, November 22, 2020 and Sunday, November 29, have been cancelled. We will continue our online services at 9 am on both Sundays.

We greatly appreciate your understanding and support in this matter and pray that you will all stay well.
