

Proposed Rules

- Captain's Choice Format
- Each player hits from his or her designated tees.
- Players 65 or older play from designated Senior tees.
- Players 80 or older play from Red Tees
- Captain will choose best shot for the group, all players will hit the next shot from that spot.
- Balls may be placed within one club length of the ball that is chosen to be played, no closer to the hole, except when on the green.
- Balls must remain in same type lie as shot chosen, i.e.: Fairway/Fairway, Rough/Rough, Sand/Sand, etc.
- There will be four (4) designated par 3's for closest to the pin prizes. Ball must be on the green to qualify.
- There will be two (2) designated Long Drive Holes (one for men and one for women). Ball must be in the fairway to qualify.
- Mulligans may not be used to qualify for closest to the pin or long drive prizes.

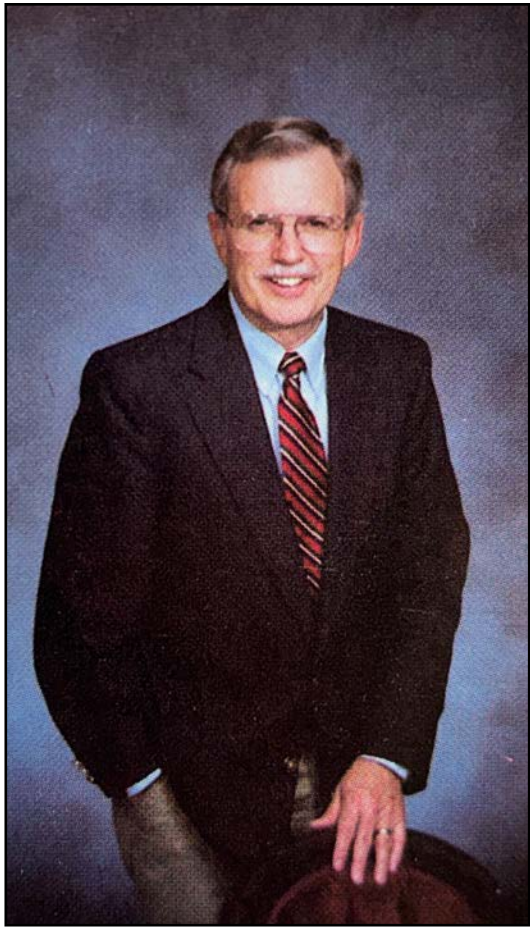

JACK KIRK

Jack Kirk was the pastor at Archdale Friends Meeting from 1988-1993. He had the ability to encourage others and see hidden talents in everyone he knew. He was a wonderful teacher and was instrumental in starting several bible study groups within the Meeting. He mentored members of all ages and helped them grow in their spiritual life. Jack was a dreamer and was involved in the planning and development of the Family Life Center, as he saw the need for a Quaker School in the community. He was known for his quick wit, enthusiasm, and the many handwritten notes he sent over the years. His life was a sermon, and he made an impact on the lives he touched.

John "Jack" Worrell Kirk passed away July 24, 2026. He leaves behind his wife Janet of 66 years, his daughter Jennie Stegall and husband Matt; his son, Chad Kirk; his grandchildren, Kyle Kirk Diehl (Mike), Tanner Kirk, Hannah Stegall, Abby Stegall, and Seth Stegall; and his great-grandchildren, Wyatt, Jed, and Mary Jo Diehl. He is also survived by Janet's brother and sister and many cousins.

Jack graduated from Earlham College where he met Janet. He devoted his life to ministry and faithfully served Friends Meetings and Quaker organizations for more than forty years. He pastored at Fairfield Friends Meeting in Indiana, New Garden Friends Meeting, University Friends Meeting in Kansas, and Bakersville Friends. He was the past editor of Quaker Life Magazine and involved in numerous Quaker organizations.
