Colossians 3: 1-4

Before you read Colossians 3:1-4, go back and read part of last week's passage, Colossians 2:6-7.

What is the key instruction that Paul gives to the Colossian believers in response of their relationship with Christ?

What is the practical step that Paul gives in Colossians 3:1 to help us accomplish the instruction he gave in Colossians 2:6? What are some additional practical steps you could take to accomplish the goal which Paul gave?

“Seek the things that are above.”

What are the “things that are above” mentioned in Colossians 3:1 and how do we seek them?

What is Paul referring to when he says we should not set our minds on “things that are on earth?”

Paul keeps the action of “seeking things above” purposefully rooted in Christ by reminding us that Christ is our life and our life is above.

According to Colossians 3:1-4, in what specific ways is Christ the center of the past, present, and future aspects of our eternal life?

How would you explain what Paul means when he says that our lives are “hidden with Christ in God?”
