Colossians 4:2-6

The Apostle Paul starts out this passage with an admonition to 'continue steadfastly in prayer.' What does that mean to you and how does that play out in our busy day?

We mentioned that prayer is like 'uncharted territory', in that God desires to take us down some paths that we have never travelled. How does that make you feel?

In Exodus 33, (would be good to read this entire passage of scripture) we find many descriptive words, phrases, and exchanges between God and Moses. What things can we learn from this passage in helping us with our communion in prayer with God?

Lastly, we talked about how the Spirit of God lives within us and that uncommon communion should bring about behavioral change in our lives. The apostle Paul had discussed this earlier in Colossians as well (ex. set your mind on things above), so how are you doing with changes in your life?
