

**MOSES: When God calls a leader  
Exodus 3:1-12**

**In Moses' story, we see God orchestrating and working through the circumstances of Moses' daily life to get his attention. Once God had Moses' attention, God then called Moses to do something.**

*Do you (i) believe in "coincidences" or (ii) do you think all "coincidences" are actually God purposefully working through circumstances?*

*Has God ever worked through circumstances in your life to get your attention? If you feel comfortable, share with the group that story.*

*Has God ever worked through your circumstances to "call" you to do something for Him? If you feel comfortable, share with the group that story.*

**Prior to calling Moses to lead the people, God reminded Moses that He cared for him.**

*Do you think that God cares for you?*

*Is that easy for you to believe and accept? Is it sometimes hard to accept that?*

*What, if anything, are things you regularly do to help remind yourself of God's deep love and care for you?*

*What are things you could do to help remind yourself of God's deep love and care for you?*

**Linked with Moses' call was Moses' need to have proper view of God. He needed to know God and respond to God, as He truly is.**

*Is there a connection between one's proper view of God and one's willingness to obey God?*

*How do people arrive at an improper view of God?*

*How do people arrive at a proper view of God?*

*What is the most challenging thing for you to understand or believe about God?*

*What is the most encouraging truth about God?*
